Bathroom Design Ideas

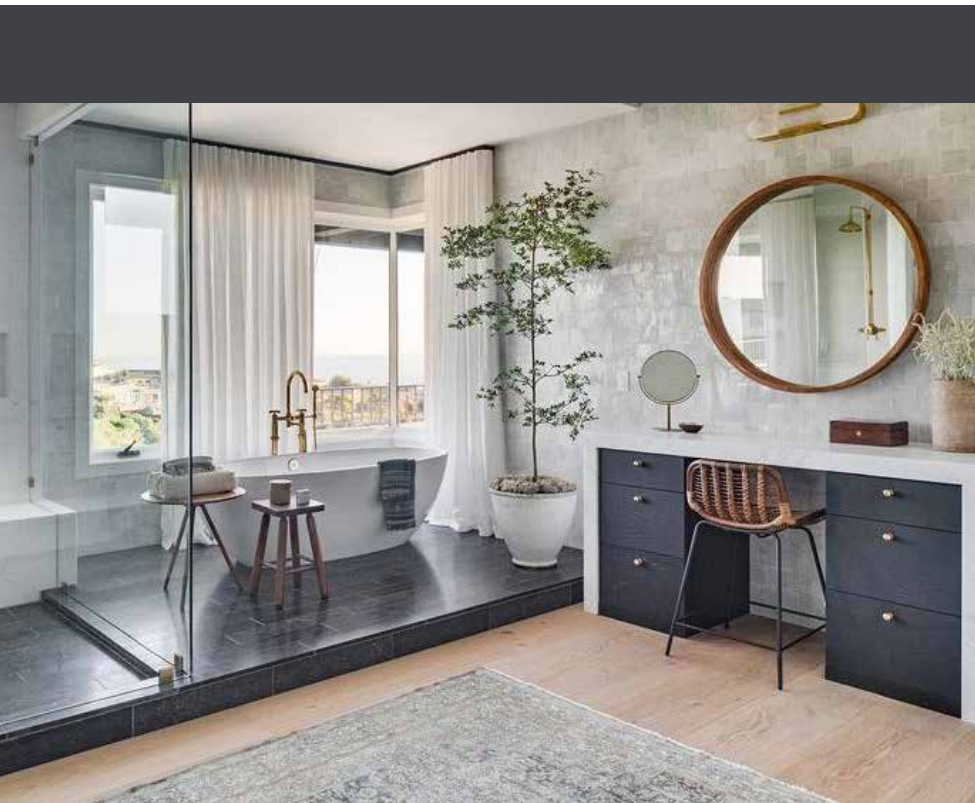


Top designers can't get enough of this classic color scheme.

When it comes to classic color schemes, it doesn't get any better than black and white. Whether you're partial to rustic retreats or sleek, modern spaces, this color combination is always full of style. Plus, it's regularly a popular choice for some of today's top interior designers.

FLOOR-FOCUSED

Patterned flooring, large subway tiles, and brass fixtures inject personality into this black and white bathroom designed by Alex Caratachea.



CALIFORNIA COOL

For the master bathroom in a Newport Beach family home, Shannon McLaren Wilkins adhered to a clean and airy design scheme. Upgrades include a custom shower with basalt flooring, a marble seat, and an elegant “her” vanity.



CHIC BLACK AND WHITE

Fashion designer Neil Barrett’s Milan master bathroom is proof that black and white doesn’t have to be boring. Thanks to the walls and flooring in Carrara marble, along with sinks by Ideal Standard, and a bamboo chair by R&Y Augusti, the space is a lesson in design.

CLASSIC STRIPES

A striped wallpaper by Ralph Lauren Home adds a sophisticated elegance to a master bathroom in a Roman Palazzo, which was transformed by architect Achille Salvagni. The design also features a 1930s Venini chandelier, tub fittings by Lefroy Brooks, and a heirloom 1750 Italian stool.



STATEMENT MARBLE

A master bathroom designed by David Netto and architect Gil P. Schaefer features walls in Benjamin Moore's Dove Wing, Paonazzo marble flooring from BAS Stone, as well as a custom Urban Archaeology vanity with Lefroy Brooks fittings.



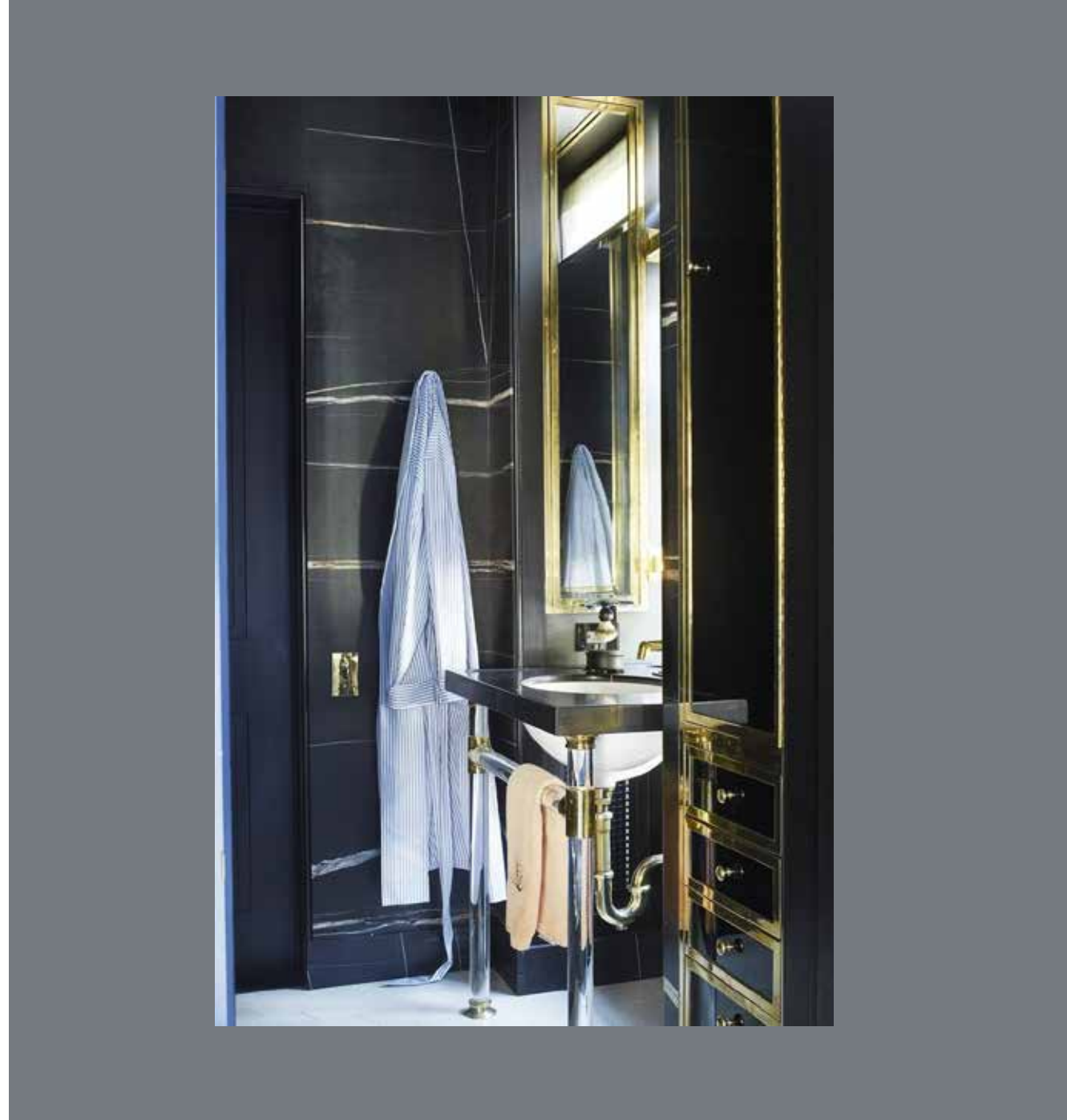
LEAFY WALLPAPER

Leafy wallpaper adds a playful touch to this black and white children's bathroom by designer Kerri Rosenthal.



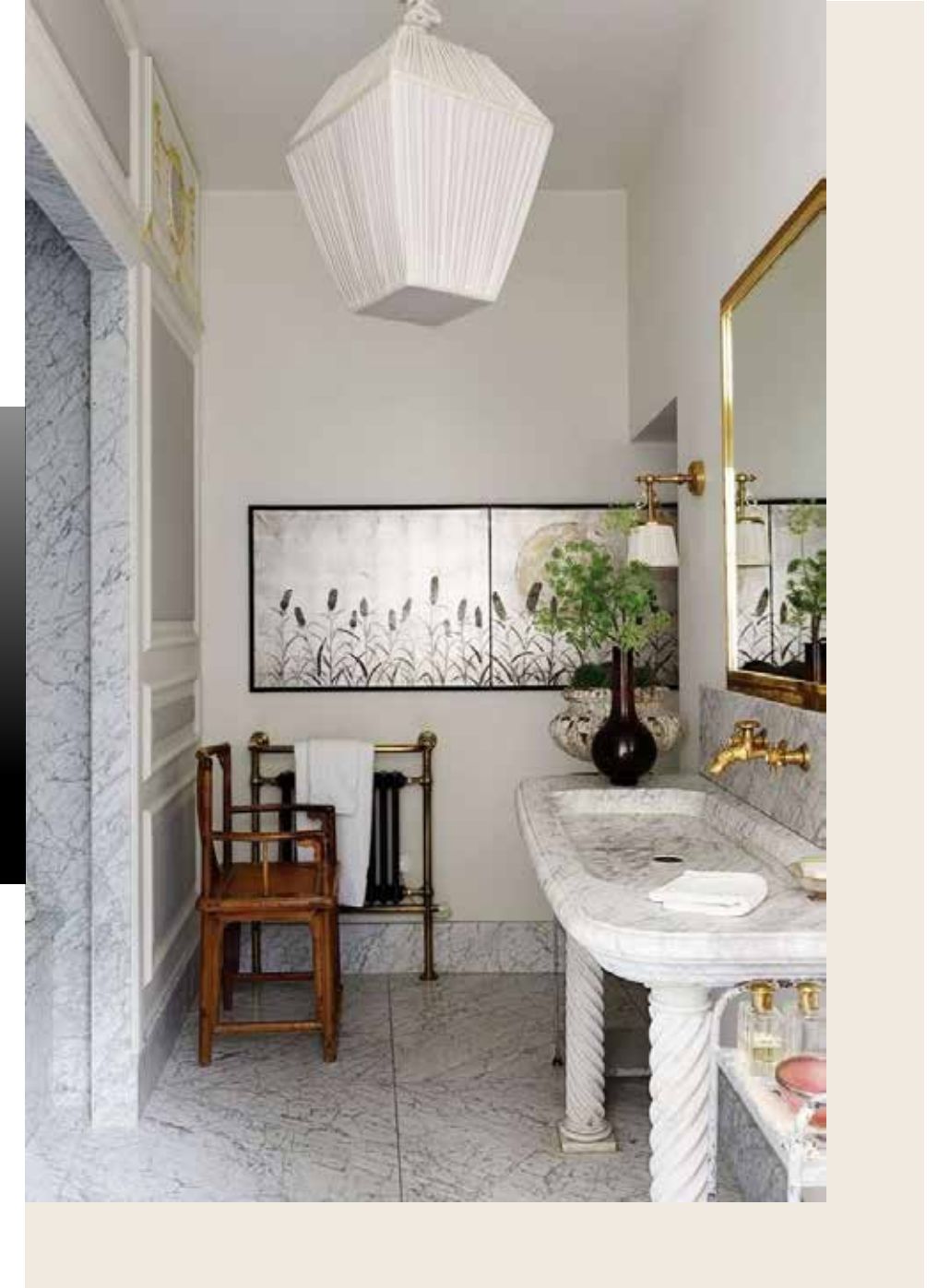
ART DECO BATHROOM

In this Art Deco pad in Chicago, the master bath's custom vanities are in Belgian black marble supported by bronze legs; the Waterworks sinks have Barber Wilsons & Co. brass fittings; the Collier Webb sconces and Charles Edwards ceiling light are custom, and the floor is Belgian Black marble with bronze inlay.



GILDED MODERN BATHROOM

In this Manhattan apartment, the masculine bathroom features a sink from Urban Archaeology. The fittings are by Waterworks, the cabinets are black glass with brass trim, the walls are clad in Saint Laurent marble, and the flooring is limestone.



BLACK-AND-WHITE MARBLE BATHROOM

In the Paris home of designer Christopher Noto, a fabric-covered, geometric light fixture and a large, gold-framed wall mirror accents the marble room. The bathroom sink and tub are custom designs, and the fittings are antique. The Japanese screen on the wall is from the Edo period.



MIRRORED BATHROOM

Mirrored walls are one of the easiest ways to create the illusion of more space. Ann Pyne, head of one of America's oldest and most distinguished design firms, designed this petite bathroom for a Manhattan client using the age-old trick. A photograph by Luisa Lambri hangs above the bath.



MONOCHROMATIC BATHROOM

In fashion exec Trent Wisheart's home in South Orange, New Jersey, the small bathroom is decked out in varying shades of gray. A 1920s Venetian mirror hangs above the sink and the tiles are by Waterworks.



BLACK TUB, WHITE TILES

In Amanda Seyfried's Catskills retreat, the master bath's custom vanity has fittings by Waterworks, the sconce is from Design Within Reach, the floor tile is by Heath Ceramics, and the beadboard is painted in Farrow & Ball's Dimpse.



OPEN BATHROOM

In this crisply elegant home in Tampa, Florida, designed by Nate Berkus, a spherical chandelier and a repurposed bookcase offer contrasting shadows to the bright white, airy space.

MINIMALIST BATHROOM

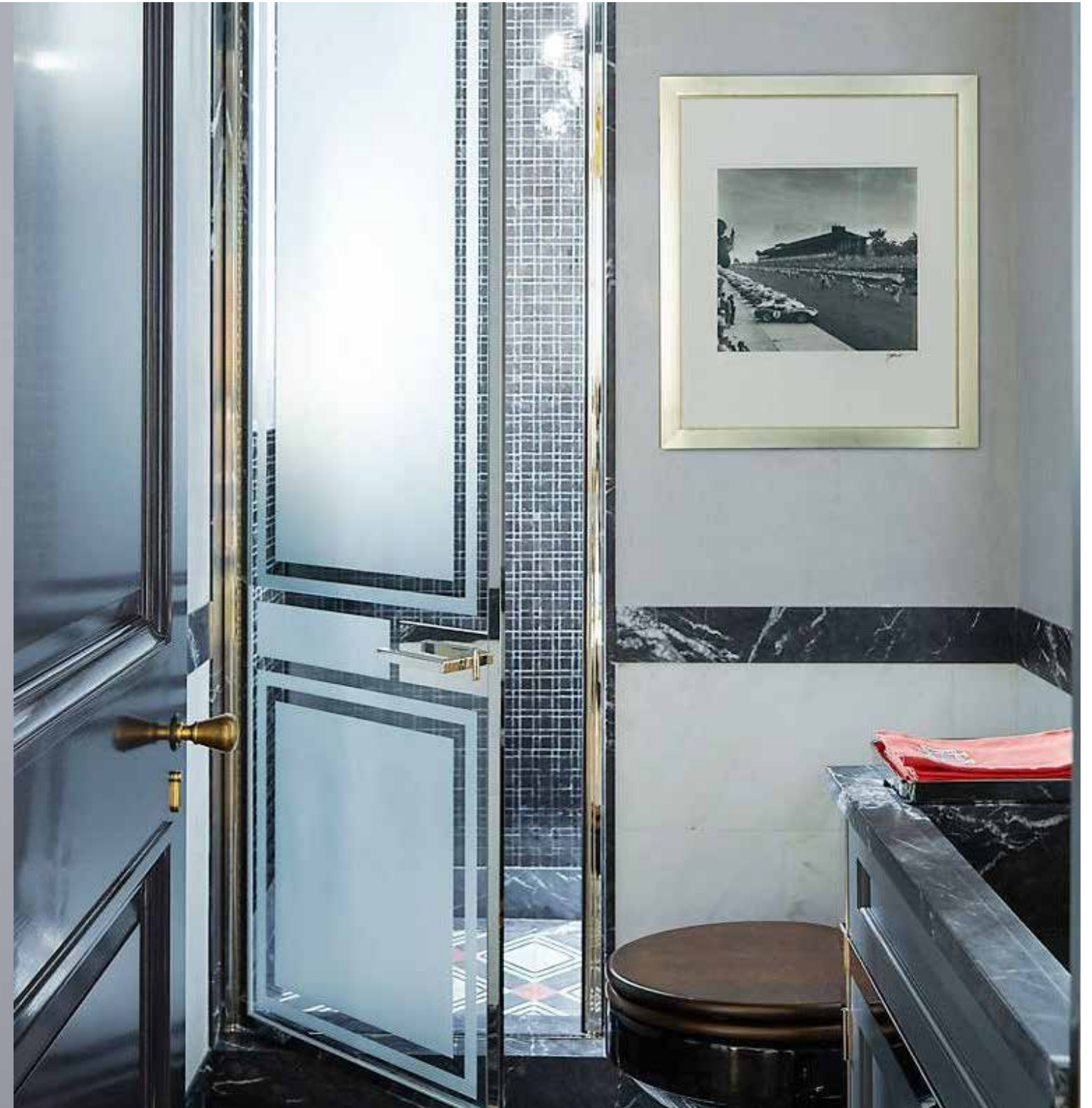
This Swedish farmhouse's bathroom takes black and white from classic to rustic. The vintage tub features fittings by Mora Armatur and the floor is tiled with Carrara marble.





WHITE MARBLE BATHROOM

A Greenwich Village pied-a-terre for designers to the stars Waldo Fernandez and Tommy Clements offers a touch of modern black and white design in high style. The sconces are by Ozone, the bathroom vanity and tub are by Waterworks, and the fittings are by Lefroy Brooks. The walls are sheathed in Calacatta Viola marble.



SILVER BATHROOM

Black and white are the principle colors in this Steven Gambrel-designed Manhattan home. The custom-designed metallic-and-marble shower door and vanity add a shiny pop of color. The floors and shower feature tiles by Mosaic House.



BLACK-AND-WHITE MASTER BATHROOM

A Notting Hill townhouse's master bath is sheathed in black Nero Marquina marble, a striking contrast to the large white sink. The 1950s slipper chair is by Ico Parisi, and the 1950s vase by Ercole Barovier was found at a Paris flea market.



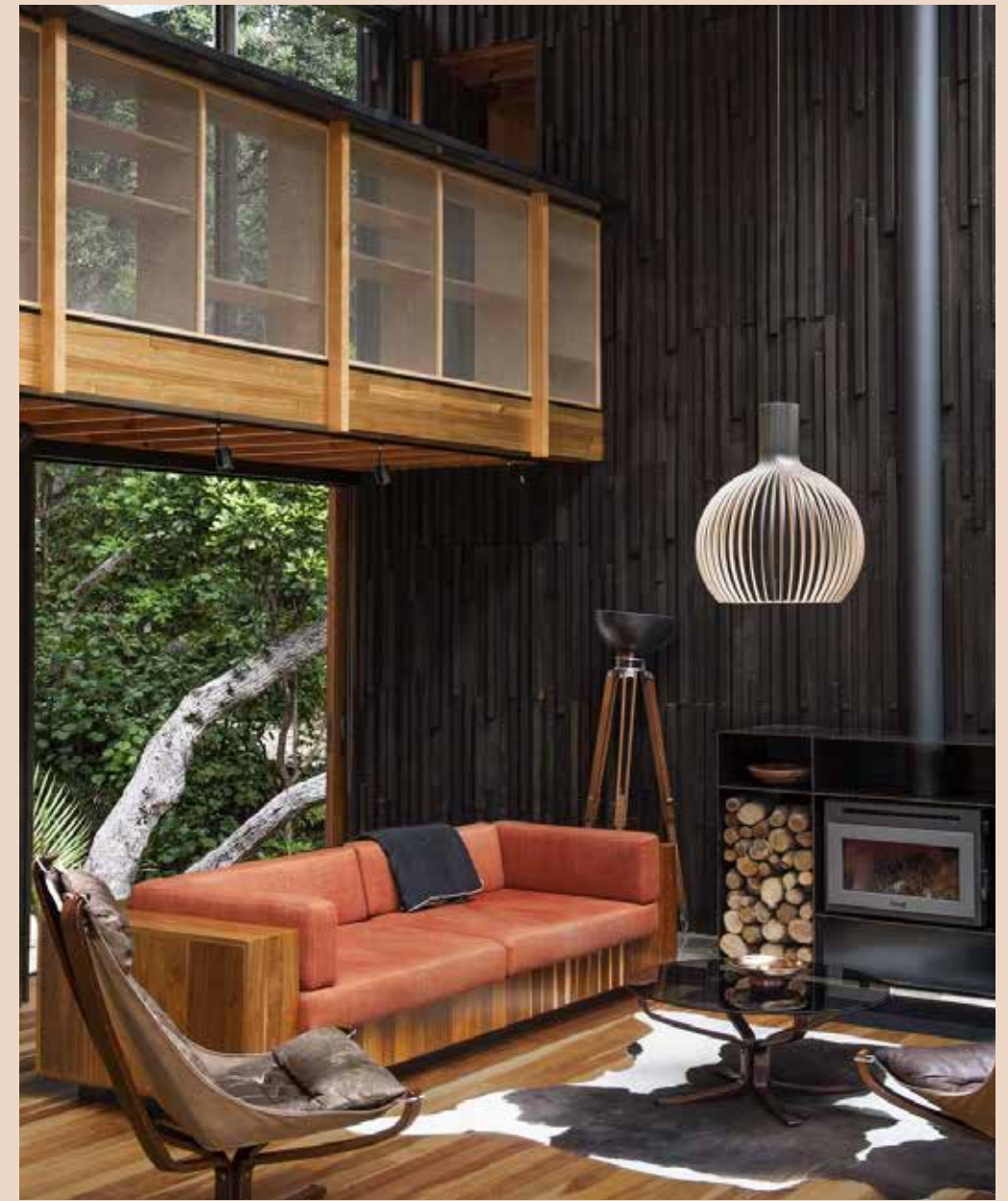
OAK BATHROOM

The cabinetry and mirror frame in Courtney Cox's master bath are ebonized white oak. The contrasting black pendant lights are custom made. The sink fittings are by Waterworks, the chair and ottoman are upholstered in a velvet by Rose Tarlow Melrose House. The artwork is by Cox's father. Tour the rest of the home here.

ELEGANT+ MINIMALIST

Living Room Designs That Spark Joy

Any top interior designer would confirm that practicing restraint can be a challenge. A smart selection of comfortable, understated furnishings, well-curated artwork, and simple decorative objects is key to a standout design scheme, but it's just as important to avoid a cluttered look.





BOLD MINIMALISM

For a Miami Beach escape, designer Lee F. Mindel settled on a seamless blend of modern touches and pop sensibilities—the perfect mix for a couple and their four children. The living room is outfitted with custom sofas in a Bergamo fabric, Marc Newson tables from Cappellini, and a 1980s side table by Vistosi. Mindel

enhanced the design scheme with the eye-catching Face à Face bench by Pierre Paulin through Ralph Pucci, and a custom rug by V'Soske. The bookshelf, which is also custom, features a collection of vases and ceramics from Luminaire and Jalan Jalan.



COZY MINIMALIST SEATING

A sitting area in the library of a minimalist Tuscan home overlooks the Maremma parkland; the Le Corbusier chairs are from Cassina, and the rug is by Golran.

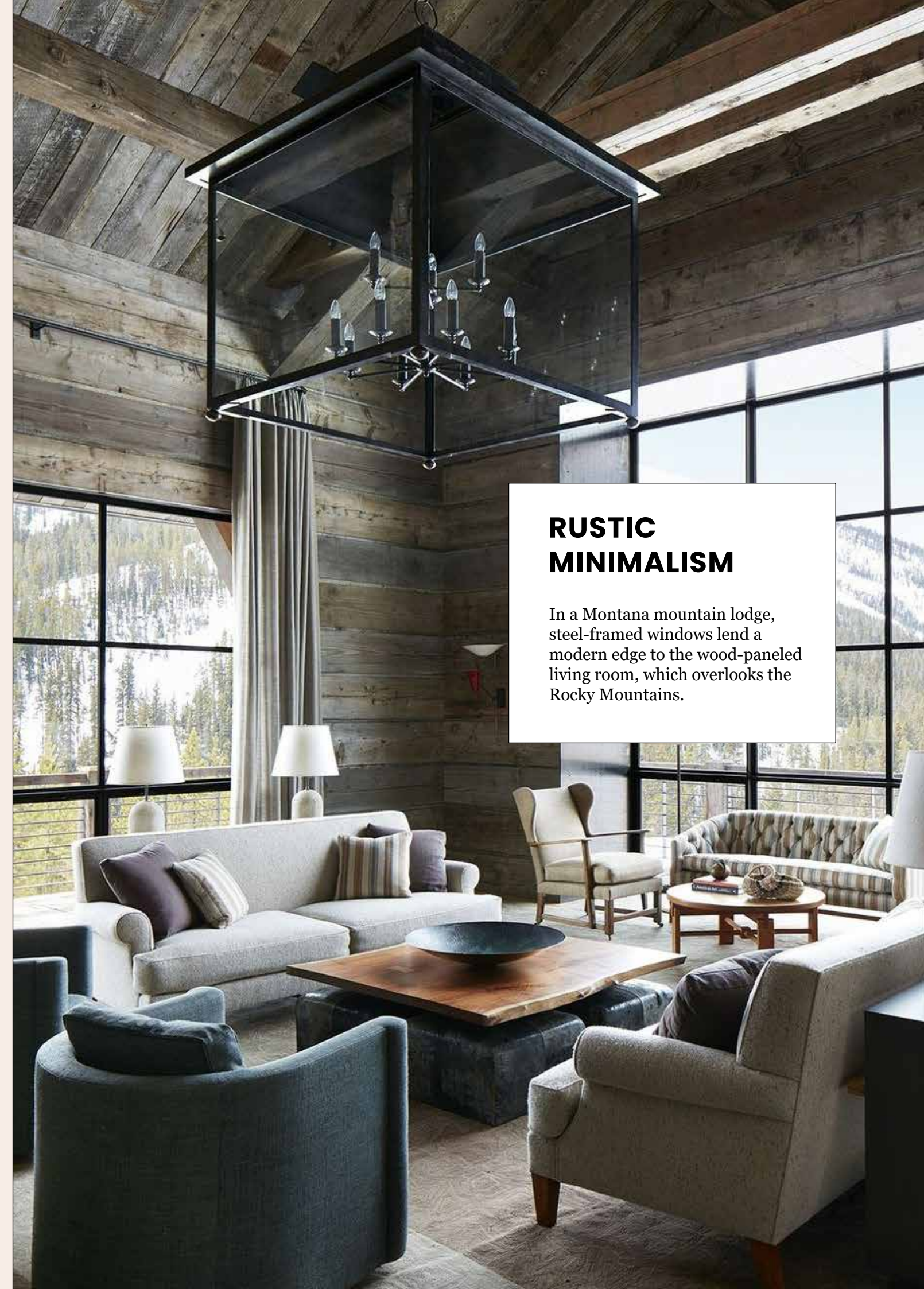


TIMELESS APPEAL

In this room designed by Peter Som for The Inside, the minimal wall art isn't noticeable thanks to a bold striped club chair and a patterned room divider.

BOLD MINIMALISM

An 18th-century sofa covered in a Fabricut fabric faces a wardrobe custom made from reclaimed wood and a Queen Anne corner chair in the bedroom of this Woodstock, NY home; the rug is vintage, the walls are painted in a custom C2 Paint color, and the ceiling and floors are of reclaimed wood.



RUSTIC MINIMALISM

In a Montana mountain lodge, steel-framed windows lend a modern edge to the wood-paneled living room, which overlooks the Rocky Mountains.



WHITE MEETS GRAY

A gray marble hearth flanked by cut-outs stacked with logs is the centerpiece for this white and gray masterpiece. Iron details anchor the otherwise airy room.



UNDERSTATED MINIMALIST LOUNGE

A daybed made by a local artisan and a Rajasthani cocktail table furnish a lounge in the rural Jaipur home of a jewel scion.



ECLECTIC MINIMALISM

In the living room of Kate and Rem Reynolds's townhouse in Windsor Terrace, Brooklyn, the sofa from ABC Carpet & Home is upholstered in a fabric by Soraya Shah for Studio Four NYC, the design showroom Kate Reynolds co-owns.

CITY LIVING

This Alyssa Kapito-designed living room in a SoHo duplex adheres to a warm neutral palette.



PARED-DOWN LOOK

Interior designer Kathryn Ireland adopted a less-is-more approach for a Los Angeles property with picturesque views out over the Pacific Ocean and the Santa Monica Mountains.



EXOTIC CONCRETE

In the living room of this Uruguayan retreat, the custom daybed is from Lucila Del Campo, a shop in the nearby resort town of La Barra.



CHARMING ABODE

In Jeremiah Brent and Nate Berkus' Los Angeles home, a marble coffee table anchors two white sofas and a black chair. Wideplank wood floors in a honey oak tone provide a mellow base.



PERFECT RESTRAINT

In a renovated spec house, the console is from Restoration Hardware, and the overhead light fixture is from Lambert & Fils. The custom limestone mantle was designed in house, and the low vintage coffee table was repainted. A speckled gray sofa from CB2 pairs well with vintage lounge chairs reupholstered in fabric from Holly Hunt.



WOOD VARIETALS

In the living area of a New Zealand house the sofa is a custom design, and the fireplace by Masport Heating is set in a custom-made steel cabinet.

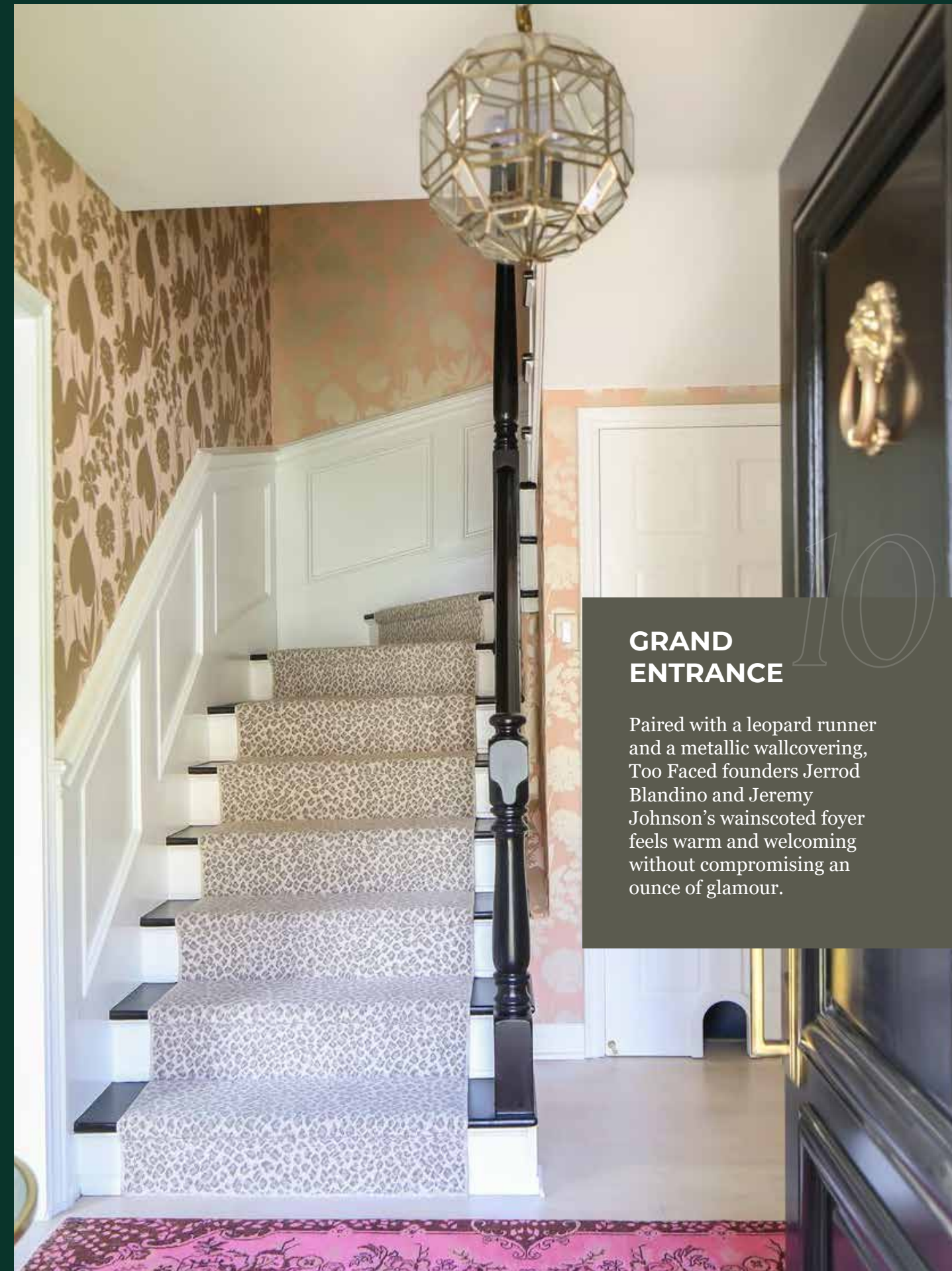
WONDERFUL WOOD

This indoor-outdoor space features a set of light blue Tolix Chairs with sheepskin throws. Design by Amy Kartheiser Design.



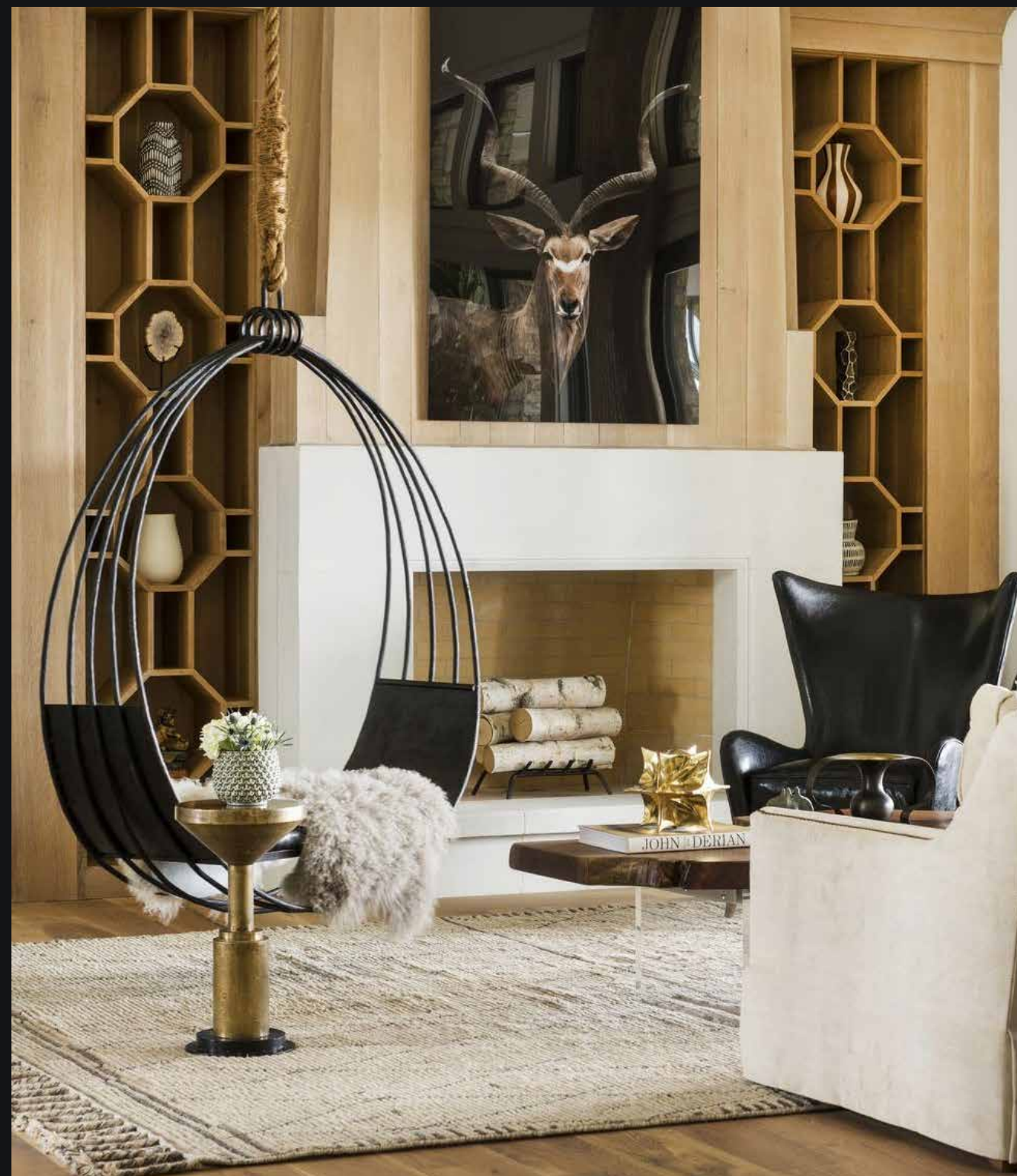
ALL ABOUT TEXTURE

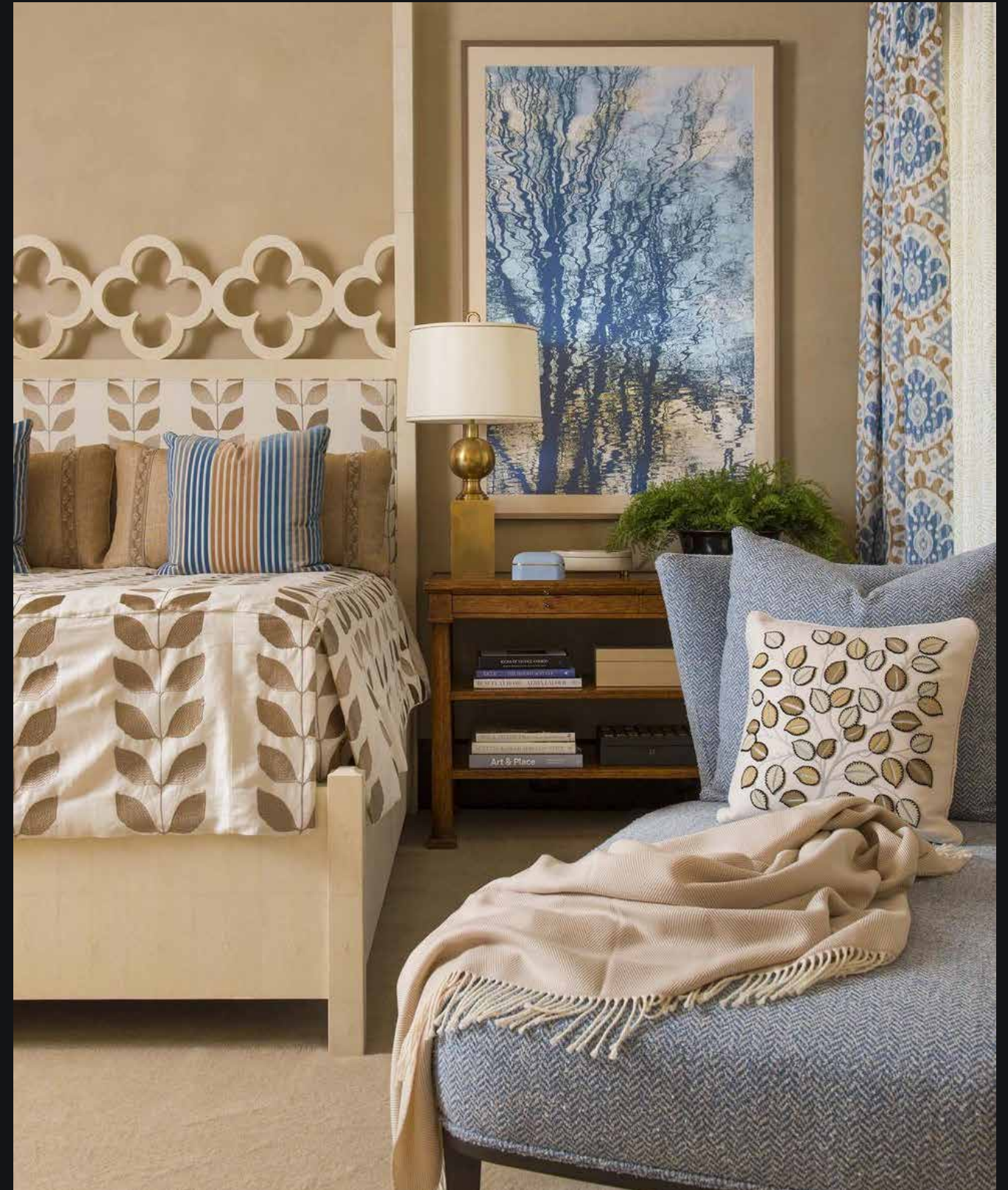

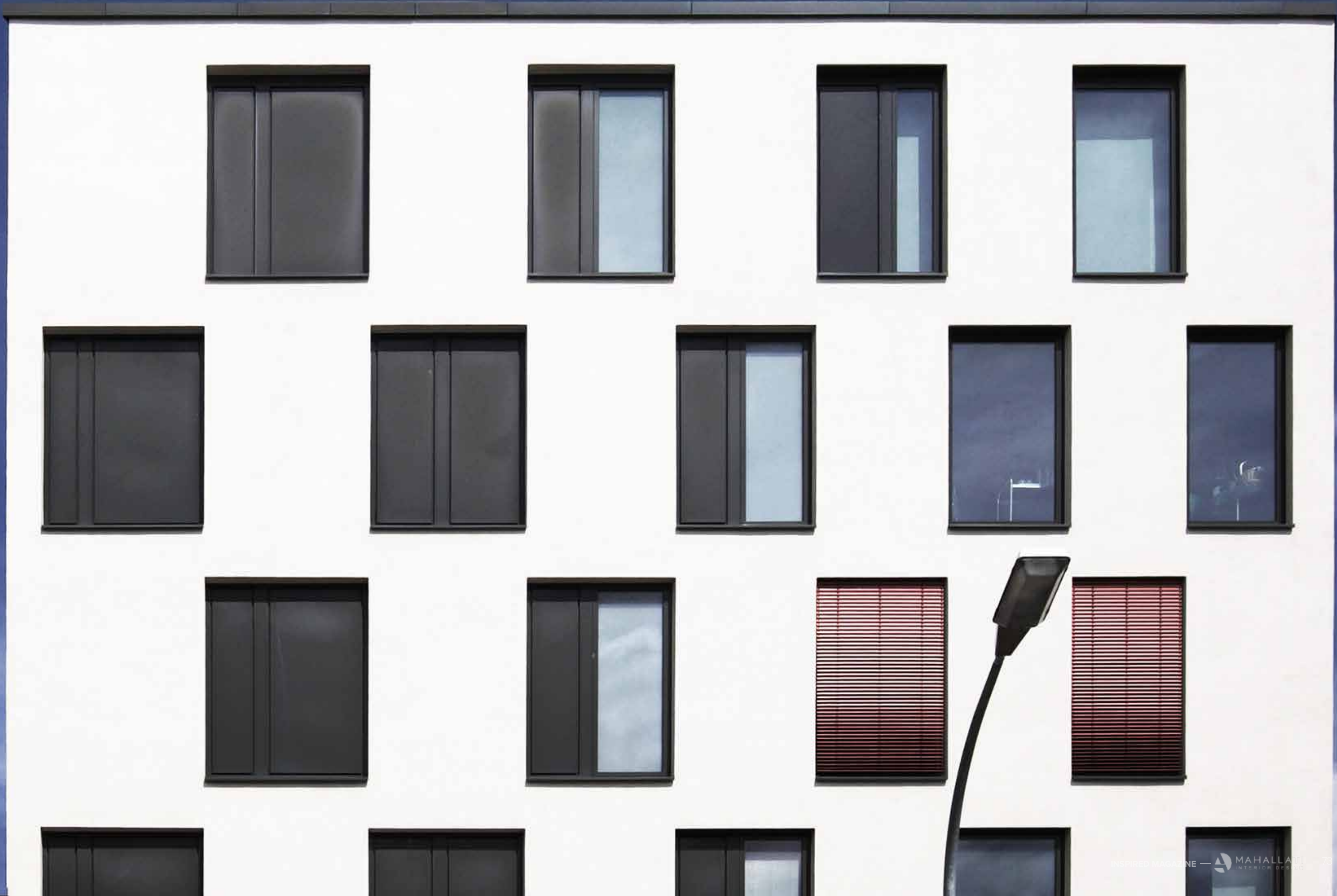


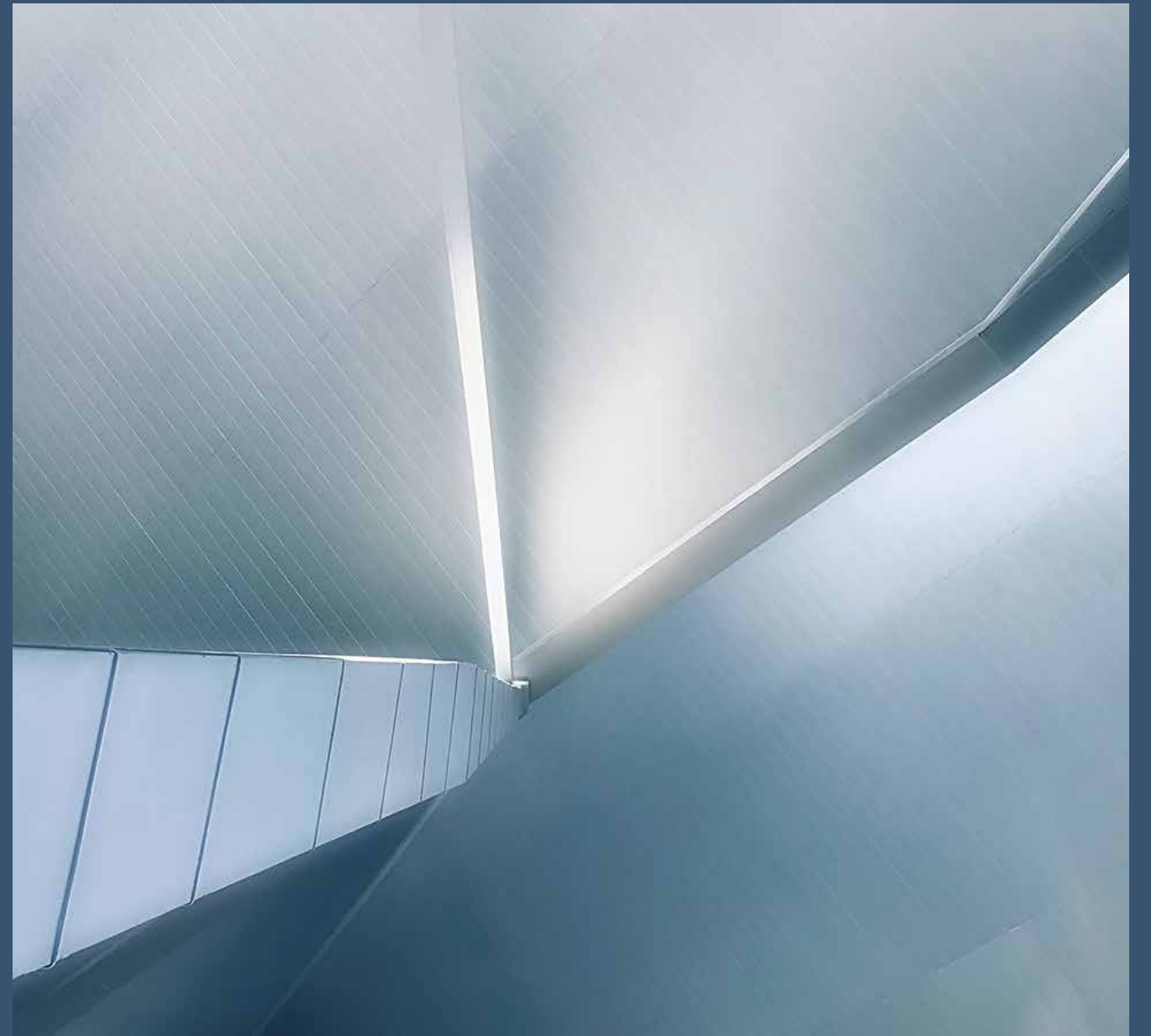
