

CLASSIC NAVY


A modern Scandinavian bathroom by Kathy Marshall Design combines large white subway tiles with a variation of square navy tiles.













COMPACT LOFT LIVING






In an open-concept loft designed by Bella Mancini, the petite kitchen space flows while feeling distinct, with white cabinetry and countertops, backdropped with dark paint.


DARK AND SLEEK

RUSTIC CONNECTICUT KITCHEN




GREY AND WHITE HUES







